Prop 19	Legalization of Marijuana Would make it legal for anyone 21 or older to possess, share or transport up to an ounce of marijuana for personal use and to grow up to 25 square feet per residence or parcel, and allow state and local governments to regulate and tax related commercial activities		✓
Prop 20	Voters First Act of Congress Would allow the Citizens Redistricting Commission to draw boundaries for US Congressional districts, in addition to legislative districts	✓	
Prop 21	Vehicle License Surcharge for State Parks Establishes an \$18 annual state vehicle license surcharge and grants free admission to all state parks to surcharged vehicles		✓
Prop 22	Prohibits State from Taking Local Funds Prohibits the state from taking, borrowing, or redirecting local taxpayers funds dedicated to public safety, emergency response and other vital local government services.	✓	
Prop 23	Suspends AB 32 Until Unemployment Drops Suspends state laws regulating greenhouse gas emissions until California's unemployment rate drops to 5.5 percent (or less) for four consecutive quarters.		✓
Prop 24	Repeals Legislation that Lowered Business Taxes Repeals three pieces of recent legislation, scheduled to take effect for the 2011 tax year, which would allow businesses to reduce their tax burden.		✓
Prop 25	Changes Budget Vote to Simple Majority Changes the legislative vote requirement necessary to pass the state budget from two-thirds to a simple majority.		✓
Prop 26	Supermajority Vote to Pass New Taxes and Fees Act Makes it more difficult for policymakers to use a loophole in the law to pass taxes on products and services simply by calling them "fees" instead of taxes.	✓	
Prop 27	Eliminates Citizen Redistricting Commission Eliminates the 14-member redistricting commission recently passed by voters and gives the authority to draw district lines back to elected officials.		✓
